

# Referral Pathway Somali Outreach Project

## **Description of the Service**

# Purpose:

To provide an information, advice and support service to members of the Somali communities in Hillingdon who are experiencing emotional well-being or mental health issues.

#### **Outcomes:**

- 1. members of the Somali communities will report an enhanced understanding of the local pathways to mental health support;
- 2. members of the Somali communities will report increased access to primary care mental health support;
- 3. faith leaders within the Somali communities will report a better awareness of mental health issues.

Information and/or advice may be given on the telephone or in a face-to-face interview at a mutually convenient location in the local community.

Service Eligibility Criteria	
Somali Age 18+ Resident, or registered with a GP, in the London Borough of Hillingdon Seeking support to enhance emotional resilience and/or mental health recovery, or to overcome social isolation
